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## General Description

Consonant features: in purple

Vowel features: in green

Intonation: Intonation is generally appropriate. Both rising intonation and falling intonation are used.

Stress: Primary stresses are generally put on appropriate syllables, except four words:  
absoLUtely→ABSOLUTELY, easyGOing→EASYGOING,  
PEOPLE→PEOPLE, and BADminton→badMINTon.

Linking: Linking is rarely used (highlighted in light green).

Rhythm: The duration of unstressed function words is shorter than the tonic syllables.  
However, the unstressed syllables in content words have similar duration with stressed syllables in content words.
