
General Description

General comments:

In this recording, the student attempts to produce a total of 9 sentences, in which there are 4 simple sentences. There are also some complex constructions, including 5 complex sentences, which consist of 3 noun clauses and 6 adverbial clauses.

The student makes a total of 10 grammatical errors, in which 4 noun and pronoun errors, 3 verb errors, 1 structural error and 2 other errors.

Detailed report of grammatical errors:

Errors (10 times)

1. Noun and pronoun errors (4 times):

Wrong number (singular/plural) (4 times):

Student: ... language ... very important ...

Suggested: ... *languages* ... very important ...

Student: ... every people.

Suggested: ... every *person*.

Student: ... write some ... articles or thesis ...

Suggested: ... write some ... articles or *theses* ...

Student: ... if you need ... language every day, ...

Suggested: ... if you need ... *languages* every day, ...

2. Verb errors (3 times):

Wrong subject-verb agreement (1 time):

Student: ... language is very important ...

Suggested: ... languages *are* very important ...

Missing verbs 'to be' (1 time):

Student: ... both ^ very important ...

Suggested: ... both *are* very important ...

Confusion between gerunds, infinitives, and other verb forms (1 time):

Student: ... need you to speaking ...

Suggested: ... need you *to speak* ...

3. Structural errors (1 time):

Wrong word order (1 time):

Student: ... people study new language when he was a little children is very easy for them.

Suggested: ... *it is very easy for a person to learn a new language when he is a little child.*

4. Other errors (2 times):

Common confusing word pairs (2 times):

Student: ... maybe your boss could need you ...

Suggested: ... maybe your boss *will* need you ...

Student: I don't answer this question.

Suggested: I *can't* answer this question.
