
General Description

General comments:

In this recording, the student attempts to produce a total of 19 sentences, in which there are 9 simple sentences and 2 compound sentences. There are also some complex constructions, including 5 complex sentences and 3 compound complex sentences, which consist of 5 noun clauses and 7 adverbial clauses.

The student makes a total of 42 grammatical errors, in which 9 are article and possessive errors, 9 noun and pronoun errors, 15 verb errors, 4 conjunction errors, 2 structural errors, and 3 other errors.

Detailed report of grammatical errors:

Errors (42 times)

1. Article and possessive errors (9 times):

Extra articles (a/an/the) (3 times):

Student: ... sleep in the nature.

Suggested: ... sleep in nature.

Student: ... the home ...

Suggested: ... home ...

Student: ... in the ... nature.

Suggested: ... in ... nature.

Missing articles (a/an/the) (6 times):

Student: ... since I am ... ^ child, ...

Suggested: ... since I was ... *a* child, ...

2. Noun and pronoun errors (9 times):

Wrong number (singular/plural) (7 times):

Student: ... with my friend and my family.

Suggested: ... for my university *studies*.

Student: Yeah, I like sport ...

Suggested: Yeah, I like *sports* ...

Student: ... a sport teacher ...

Suggested: ... a *sports* teacher ...

Student: ... some sport with me.

Suggested: ... some *sports* with me.

Student: ... do some sport.

Suggested: ... do some *sports*.

Student: ... that's amazing ... things.

Suggested: ... that's an amazing ... *thing*.

Confusion between pronouns (subject/object/reflexive) (1 time):

Student: ... me and my family are always ...

Suggested: ... *I* and my family are always ...

Confusion between subject pronouns and possessive pronouns

(my/your/his/her/our/their) (1 time):

Student: ... we ... family ...

Suggested: ... *our* ... family ...

3. Verb errors (15 times):

Wrong tense or aspect (7 times):

Student: ... since I am ... child, ...

Suggested: ... since I *was* ... child, ...

Student: So, I choose this major.

Suggested: So, I *chose* this major.

Student: I often go to ...

Suggested: I often *went* to ...

Student: ... when I was a kid, he always run with me ...

Suggested: ... when I was a kid, he always *ran* with me ...

Student: ... when I was a kid, he always ... and do ...

Suggested: ... when I was a kid, he always ... and *did* ...

Student: ... when I grow up ...

Suggested: ... when I *was growing* up ...

Student: ... I like fencing.

Suggested: ... I *liked* fencing.

Wrong subject-verb agreement (1 time):

Student: But someone don't like ...

Suggested: But someone *doesn't* like ...

Extra verbs 'to be' (1 time):

Student: ... when they are play, ...

Suggested: ... when they play, ...

Missing verbs (1 time):

Student: ... all can ^ together ...

Suggested: ... all can *be* together ...

Confusion between gerunds, infinitives, and other verb forms (5 times):

Student: ... for go out ...

Suggested: ... for *going* out ...

Student: ... go ... is more ...

Suggested: ... *going* ... is more ...

Student: ... cook with family is also ...

Suggested: ... *cooking* with family is also ...

Student: ... stay ... in ... nature.

Suggested: ... *staying* ... in ... nature.

Student: ... I like watch ...

Suggested: ... I like *watching* ...

4. Conjunction errors (4 times):

Extra conjunctions (4 times):

Student: ... when they ... play, and ... are always ...

Suggested: ... when they ... play, ... are always ...

Student: And because we are ..., so, ... all can ...

Suggested: And because we are ..., ... all can ...

Student: ... home and cook with family ...

Suggested: ... home *cooking* with family ...

Student: ... when I ..., and I ...

Suggested: ... when I ..., I ...

5. Structural errors (2 times):

Wrong word order (1 time):

Student: ... one month a time ...

Suggested: ... *one time a month* ...

Missing subjects or objects (1 time):

Student: But someone don't like ^, and ...

Suggested: But someone don't like *it*, and ...

Student: ... but ... ^ is not more ... than ...

Suggested: ... but ... *it* is not more ... than ...

6. Other errors (3 times):

Common confusing word pairs (1 time):

Student: ... sometime you eat and sleep, ...

Suggested: ... *sometimes* you eat and sleep, ...

Incomplete (1 time):

Student: ... I like facing ^.

Suggested: ... I like facing [*meaning unclear*].

Extra word (1 time)

Student: ... my family are always to together ...

Suggested: ... my family are always together ...
