
General Description

Consonant features: in purple

Vowel features: in green

Intonation: Intonation is generally appropriate. Both rising intonation and falling intonation are used.

Stress: Primary stresses are generally put on appropriate syllables, except four words: **VI**sited→vi**S**ited, **VI**sit→vi**S**it, **P**owerpoint→power**P**oint, **mis**TAKES → **MIS**TAKES

Linking: Linking is rarely used (highlighted in light green).

Rhythm: The duration of unstressed function words is shorter than the tonic syllables. However, the tonic syllables have similar duration with stressed syllables in content words and function word.

e.g.

Student:

I like to say something about the first time I talk in English.

Suggested:

I like to say something about the first time I talk in English.
