
General Description

General comments:

In this recording, the student attempts to produce a total of 25 sentences, in which there are 13 simple sentences, 1 compound sentence, and 1 question. There are also some complex constructions, including 9 complex sentences and 2 compound complex sentences, which consist of 6 noun clauses, 7 adverbial clauses, and 2 relative clauses.

The student makes a total of 23 grammatical errors, in which 2 are article and possessive errors, 4 noun and pronoun errors, 9 verb errors, 1 preposition error, 2 conjunction errors, 1 structural error, and 4 other errors.

Detailed report of grammatical errors:

Errors (23 times)

1. Article and possessive errors (2 times):

Extra articles (a/an/the) (1 time):

Student: ... I like the American dramas.

Suggested: ... I like American drama.

Inappropriate articles (a/an/the) (1 time):

Student: ... we have the high-speed ... there.

Suggested: ... we have *a* high-speed ... there.

2. Noun and pronoun errors (4 times):

Wrong number (singular/plural) (3 times):

Student: ... this major ...

Suggested: ... this *major* ...

Student: ... I like ... American dramas.

Suggested: ... I like American *drama*.

Student: ... towards event or the current affairs ...

Suggested: ... towards *events* or the current affairs ...

Missing nouns (1 time):

Student: I hope I can pass the IELTS ^ ...

Suggested: I hope I can pass the IELTS *test* ...

3. Verb errors (9 times):

Wrong tense or aspect (6 times):

Student: And why I choose English ...

Suggested: And why I *chose* English ...

Student: ... I have already learn it ...

Suggested: ... I *had* already *learned* it ...

Student: ... because I choose this ...

Suggested: ... because I *chose* this ...

Student: ... I'm keen on language ...

Suggested: ... I *have been* keen on language ...

Student: But in my childhood, ... I just follow ...

Suggested: But in my childhood, ... I just *followed* ...

Student: ... the opinions ... my parents ... give me ...

Suggested: ... the opinions ... my parents ... *gave* me ...

Wrong subject-verb agreement (1 time):

Student: ... my view have changed a lot.

Suggested: ... my view *has* changed a lot.

Extra verbs 'to be' (1 time):

Student: I'm kind of hate change.

Suggested: I kind of hate change.

Confusion between gerunds, infinitives, and other verb forms (1 time):

Student: ... something change there.

Suggested: ... something *changed* there.

4. Preposition errors (1 time):

Missing prepositions (1 time):

Student: ... I haven't been ^ my hometown ...

Suggested: ... I haven't been *in* my hometown ...

5. Conjunction errors (2 times):

Extra conjunctions (1 time):

Student: ... why I ... is because ...

Suggested: ... why I ... is ...

Inappropriate conjunctions (1 time):

Student: ... as a primary school, I ...

Suggested: ... *since* primary school, I ...

6. Structural errors (1 time):

Student: ... the score I am not really satisfied.

Suggested: ... *I am not really satisfied with the score.*

7. Other errors (4 times):

Extra words (2 times):

Student: ... the opinions ... my parents ... give me ... their judgement.

Suggested: ... the opinions ... my parents ... gave me.

Student: ... something change there.

Suggested: ... something changed.

Common confusing word pairs (1 time):

Student: ... I think it's must have ... something ... there.

Suggested: ... I think *there* must *be* ... something ... there.

Missing words (1 time):

Student: ... ^ why I ... is ...

Suggested: ... *the reason* why I ... is ...
