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## General Description

Consonant features: in purple

Vowel features: in green

Intonation: Intonation is generally appropriate. Both rising intonation and falling intonation are used. However, rising intonation is used inappropriately at the end of a sentence.

Stress: Primary stresses are generally put on appropriate syllables, except two words: **CHANges**→**CHANGES**, **Exercises**→**exCIses**

Linking: Linking is sometimes used (highlighted in light green).

Rhythm: The duration of some unstressed function words is shorter than the stressed syllables in content words. However, some unstressed function words have similar duration with the stressed syllables in content words.
