

## General Description

Consonant features: in purple

Vowel features: in green

Intonation: Intonation is generally appropriate. Both rising intonation and falling intonation are used.

Stress: Primary stresses are put on appropriate syllables, except a few words:

koREA→KOREA, LUckily→LUCKILY, ANswer→ANSWER,  
converSAtion→CONVERSATION, japaNESE→Japanese, and  
oCCAasion→oCCASION.

Linking: Linking is usually used (highlighted in light green).

Rhythm: The duration of unstressed function words is shorter than the tonic syllables. However, the unstressed function words have similar duration with stressed syllables in content words.

e.g.

Student:

...we went to Korea in that summer with my mother and my sister.

o O oOOOo o Oo o O Oo o o Oo

Suggested:

...we went to Korea in that summer with my mother and my sister.

o O ooOoo o Oo o O Oo o o Oo
