
General Description

Consonant features: in purple

Vowel features: in green

Intonation: Intonation is generally appropriate. Both rising intonation and falling intonation are used.

Stress: Primary stresses are put on appropriate syllables.

Linking: Linking is often used (highlighted in light green).

Rhythm: The duration of unstressed function words is shorter than the tonic syllables, and the unstressed syllables in content words have shorter duration with the stressed syllables.

e.g.

Student:

Because I love languages since I was a child and I have studied English

oO oO Ooo o o o o Oo o o Oo Oo

for more than ten years...

o o o o O

Suggested:

Because I love languages since I was a child and I have studied English
