
General Description

Consonant features: in purple

Vowel features: in green

Intonation: Intonation is generally appropriate. Both rising intonation and falling intonation are used.

Stress: Primary stresses are put on appropriate syllables.

Linking: Linking is frequently used (highlighted in light green).

Rhythm: The duration of unstressed function words is shorter than the tonic syllables. However, the unstressed function words have similar duration with the stressed syllables in content words.
